Mat 19:17 NLT

Numbers 25:10-11 NIV

For <u>the Lord will not reject his people</u>; he will never forsake his inheritance.

The Lord said to Moses, "Phinehas son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron, the priest, has turned my anger away from the Israelites; **for he was a zealous as I am** for my honor among them, so that in my zeal I did not put an end to them.

[God is zealous to defend HIS honor!]

## God is ... capable

Gen 18:14 NIV

I took you from the ends of the earth, from its farthest corners I called you. I said, "you are my servant"; I have chosen you and have not rejected you. So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

<u>Is anything too difficult for the Lord?</u> At the appointed time I will return to you, at this time next year, and Sarah will have a son.

#### I am ... confident

Psalm 27:3 NIV

## God is ... gracious

Ex 22:27 NASB

Though an army besiege me, my heart will not fear; though war break out against me, **even then** will I be confident.

...for that is his only covering; it is his cloak for his body. What else shall he sleep in? And it shall come about that when he cries out to Me, I will hear him, **for I am gracious.**

Psalm 27:10 NIV

#### God is ... zealous

Isaiah 42:13 NIV

Though my father and mother forsake me. the Lord will receive me.

The Lord will march out like a mighty man, like a warrior <u>he will stir up his zeal</u>; with a shout he will raise the battle cry and will triumph over his enemies.
